Job Description

Summary of Position

Conduct tests to determine quality of raw materials and products produced meet required specifications, maintaining all Quality Assurance records and managing all internal quality systems, including SQF.

Role and Responsibilities

- Check thoroughly and sign off on all jobs including WIP during shift
- Maintain, update and **train** Work Instructions and audits
- Perform job required testing on **all press/finishing retains, including filing samples away**
- Inspect materials, products, or equipment to detect defects or malfunctions
- Investigate, log and process all raw material and internal non-conformances and update graphs
- Confirm compliance and update logs for all incoming raw materials
- Generate custom Tech data sheets for customers
- Perform Non-conformance audits
- Ensuring Quality and Food Safety procedures are in place. QA Technician assumes role in Lead QA Technician’s absence.
- Maintaining SQF audit logs
- Verification and validation schedule for SQF compliance
- Other tasks as directed by supervisor.
